IN THE MATTER OF ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH REPORT

Environmental Health Sanitarian-in-Training Isaac Fouts had a positive six-month probation evaluation. Environmental Technician Mary Moser's yearly evaluation was reviewed and approved by the Health District Supervisors' Team. Chandler Wren took the plumbing plans exam and the commercial plumbing inspector test on November 1, 2023. The plumbing test was from the International Plumbing Certification. The Ohio Board of Building Standards will issue Mr. Wren an official Plumbing Inspector certificate.

IN THE MATTER OF NURSING REPORT

Health Commissioner Travis Irvan presented the September 2023 Logan County communicable disease case rates. (See Notes to Minutes for Stats) Mr. Irvan reported that the Covid-19 case numbers are increasing. Mr. Irvan stated that nurses have applied for the Director of Nursing position. Interviews are set for next week.

IN THE MATTER OF COMMUNITY HEALTH UPDATES

Director of Community Health Megan Bailey reported on the October health education opportunities, the Ohio Tobacco Quitline screenings and referrals, the number of safe sex kits distributed, health fairs attended, and the social media outreach (see Notes to the Minutes for Stats). Mrs. Bailey will be attending a meeting tomorrow to discuss a safe syringe program for Logan County. Community Health is learning about the Ohio injury prevention grant. Re-accreditation is due on April 8, 2024.

IN THE MATTER OF HEALTH COMMISSIONER COMMENTS

Health Commissioner Travis Irvan updated Board members on several items.

- The Rascal Veterinary Unit from Ohio State University is planning on coming to the Logan County Fairgrounds twice in 2024 to provide low-cost rabies vaccinations and other pet care needs.
- The District Advisory Council meeting will be on Thursday, March 21, 2024, at 6:00 p.m. Mrs. Collins' Board of Health term ends in 2024. She will not be seeking re-election.
- The Workforce Development grant from the Ohio Department of Health is mandating an all-staff training on equality. The Health District has contracted with Mighty Crow Training Company for this service.
- Several employees attended an eclipse exercise at Indian Lake to run through several scenarios that could happen in April 2024. The Health District discussed the temporary campground guidelines from the Ohio Department of Health with the local partners.
- Staff were told their pay rates for 2024, as approved in the 2024 budget by the Board. One person requested and was approved a pay decrease.
