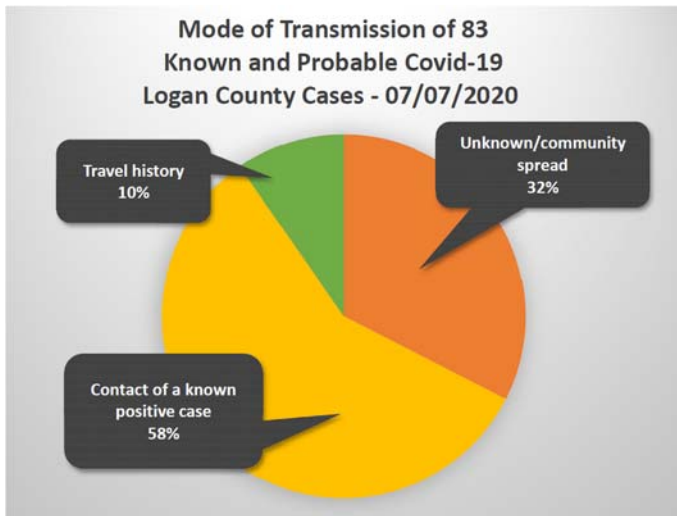


## COVID-19 Situational Report The Information in this report is from: 06/29/20 – 07/07/20

### Positive Case Etiology in Logan County (6/29/20 -7/7/20)

There are 10 new positive cases reported between Monday, June 29<sup>th</sup> through Tuesday, July 7<sup>th</sup>.

Of the 10 positive cases:

- 3 were acquired from household contact
- 1 was acquired from a co-worker in Franklin County
- 2 were acquired from an out of county wedding
- 1 was acquired from a co-worker who recently traveled (Montana)
- 1 were acquired from out of state travel (Texas)
- 2 was unknown linkage- no known confirmed exposure or recent travel

Nine out of these ten cases presented with symptoms.

### ACTIONS COMPLETED SINCE LAST SITUATIONAL REPORT:

- Began planning for conference call with schools to assist with questions and planning.
- Our public health nurses continue to interview every case of COVID-19 and notify and quarantine all close contacts. We are encouraging all people in the community to wear face coverings.
- We are conducting complaint investigations of businesses.
- We are providing information and resources and taking complaints on our call center line at 592-9040 opt #1.
- We are following health disparities related to COVID-19 to protect the health and safety of all residents.
- In addition to our COVID-19 efforts and response, we continue to provide programs and services, including WIC, TB, food inspections, immunizations (limited), Narcan distribution, newborn visits via phone and CMH program.

### LIAISON:

- Health Advisory sent to HCP's regarding COVID-19 testing in Logan County
- Requests for PPE are going through the EMA. **There are PPE available by calling the EMS at: 937-593-5743**

**LOGISTICS:**

- Received 2 new vaccine refrigerators. Vaccines are now in the emergency vaccine coolers, waiting for the new refrigerators to stabilize.

**STATE INFORMATION:**

- Pop up testing continues in urban areas. Testing in rural areas is limited.
