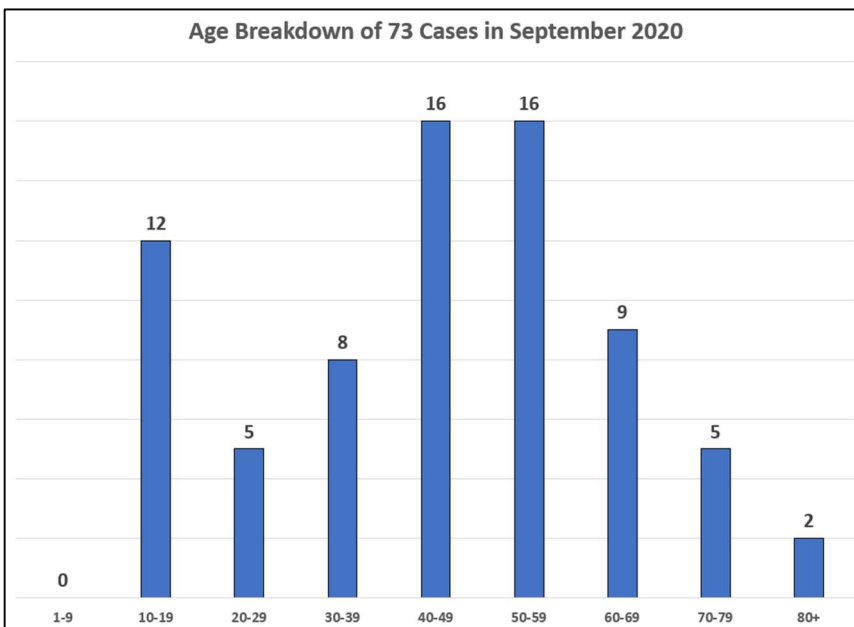

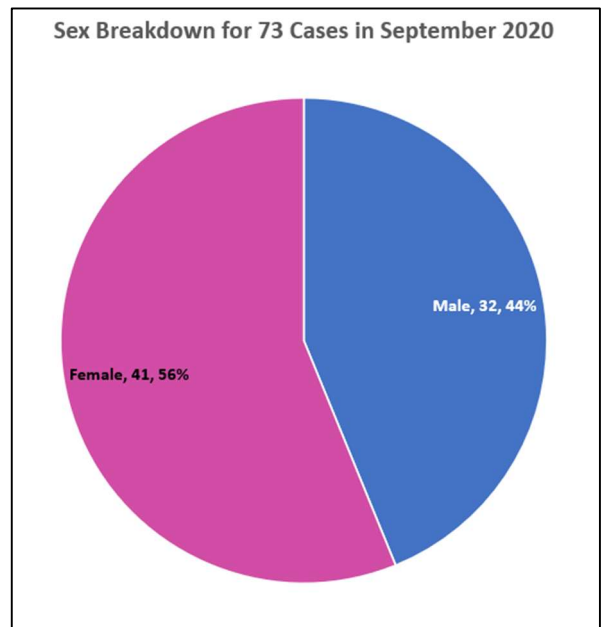
Ohio Cases: 155,314 Total; 146,438 Confirmed; 8,876 Probable; Ohio Confirmed Deaths: 4,514

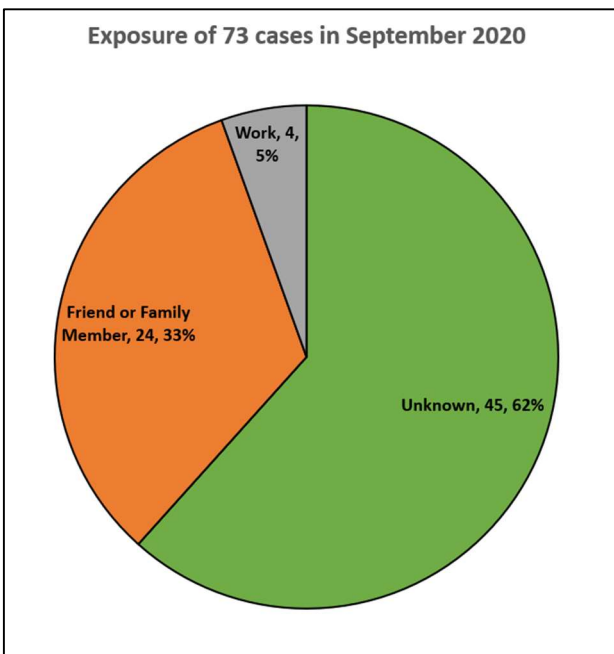
Age Breakdown of 73 Cases in September 2020



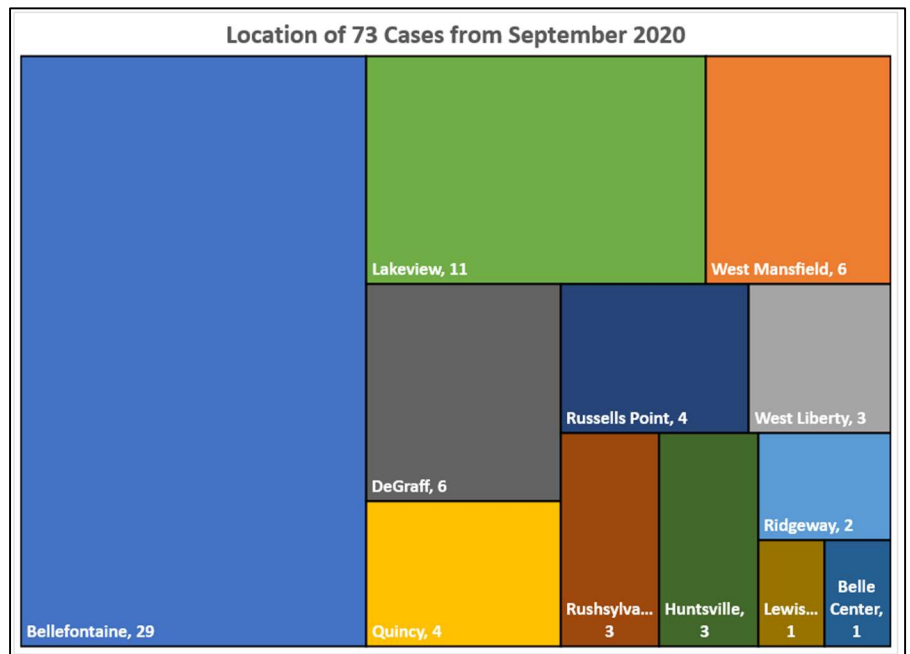
Sex Breakdown for 73 Cases in September 2020

ACTIONS COMPLETED SINCE LAST SITUATIONAL REPORT:

- Held 5 immunization clinics to catch up children needing school & other vaccines.
- Environmental Health staff continues to answer questions from community planners to make events as safe as possible.
- We are providing information and taking complaints at the numbers below, and are still using our COVID-19 email address for better communication: covid19@co.logan.oh.us
 - If you have a COVID-19 business or mask complaint, call (937) 592-9040, enter 3.
 - For COVID-19 calls requiring nursing assistance, call (937) 592-9040, enter 1.
- In addition to our COVID-19 efforts and response, we continue to provide programs and services, including vital statistics, WIC, food inspections, immunizations (limited and by appointment only), TB Testing (by appointment only), Narcan distribution, newborn visits (via phone), OCTF program and CMH program.
- Held a COVID-19 Pop-Up Test Site on September 10, 2020. Tested 71 individuals resulting in 1 lab-confirmed positive case. See Pop-Up Test Site Report for further details.
- Hired 2 additional contact tracers to assist in contact tracing efforts and an Outreach Coordinator to relieve nursing staff.
- Received contact tracing assistance from ODH

LIAISON:

- Unified Command (EMA, MRH & LCHD) continues to meet on a bi-weekly basis.
- LCHD staff continues to meet virtually with school administrators and school nurses to provide guidance.
 - Began using new reporting strategies between schools, LCHD and ODH.
- Attending weekly calls with ODH to plan for COVID-19 Vaccine distribution.
- Planning for flu vaccine clinics in the coming weeks.

LOGISTICS:

- Began testing carbon dioxide levels in schools, businesses and churches.
- Received and began distributing KN95 masks for CMH clients.

STATE INFORMATION:
